

Chapter 191

PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS

ARTICLE I Use of Town Park [Adopted 7-6-1971]

§ 191-1. General regulations.

The Pendleton Town Park and the users thereof shall be subject to the following rules:

- A. The park shall close at sundown, and all persons shall be off the premises at said time. [Amended 6-4-1996 by L.L. No. 1-1996]
- B. The park shall be used by Town of Pendleton residents only, except if a group requests the use of the park only one family or one member of the group must be a resident of Pendleton.
- C. Motor vehicles, including go-carts, mini bikes, motor bikes and motorcycles will be allowed only for the purpose of entering and leaving the park and shall be limited to the driveway and parking area.
- D. No horseback riding shall be allowed in the park.¹
- E. Reservations for the use of the park shelters shall be made by residents at the Public Works Department. [Amended 6-4-1996 by L.L. No. 1-1996]

§ 191-2. Penalties for offenses. [Amended 6-4-1996 by L.L. No. 1-1996]

All violations of this chapter or any provision thereof shall be an offense punishable by a fine not exceeding \$250 or imprisonment for not more than 15 days or both.

ARTICLE II Recreation Areas [Adopted 10-6-1998²]

§ 191-3. Blacktop walkways.

- A. The blacktop area is restricted to walking, roller blades and bicycles.
- B. Horses or motor vehicles are prohibited in the blacktop area, including three-wheelers or four-wheelers, snowmobiles, motorcycles, dirt bikes, etc.
- C. Minors using the blacktop must be supervised by an adult.
- D. Glass containers are prohibited.

§ 191-4. Use of tennis courts.

The tennis courts are to be used for tennis only.

§ 191-5. Penalties for offenses.

Violators of these rules and regulations will be prosecuted and subject to a fine of \$25 for the first offense. Second or subsequent violations will result in a fine of \$250.
