3. All players are welcome to play with no restrictions on town boundaries. We will be offering everything from T-ball to 17 and under (age eligibility for 17U is 11/30/2008). All are able to pitch and there will be no restrictions on playing time. All will receive equal playing time.
4. Clinics - In season and out of season instruction will focus on the fundamentals, position specific skills and positional responsibilities.
3. Coaching Certification - Our certification program will focus on the CNBSA coaching philosophy of instructing on the fundamentals of the game, building player confidence, emphasizing overall athleticism and FUN.
4. Vision – The CNBSA is focused on the now and future of the organization. Looking ahead 2, 5 & 10 years will allow the CNBSA to evolve and grow with the needs of the program and kids. Ideas under consideration include; concessions, equipment upgrades, enhanced uniforms, field improvements and enhancements that include; fencing, lights, or a new state of the art complex.
